Students

There are 89 students in grades 4K through 4th grade.

Staff

There are 25 Certified Teaching Staff and 8 Support Staff at Haugen. Our teachers have an average of 22 years of teaching experience.

Academic Achievement

Each grade participates in Standardized testing three times a year to measure the growth each of our students is making. We use PALS for 4K and Fastbridge for Grades K-4.

4K– PALS Assessment– 80% of students have mastered their beginning sound awareness

Math Fastbridge Assessment-earlyMath (K-1) or aMath (2-4)

At the end of the Winter assessment, the grade levels scored as follows:

Kindergarten: 94% of students scored in the Some Risk or Low Risk category

1st grade: 86% of students scored in the Some Risk or Low Risk category

2nd grade: 92% of students scored in the Some Risk or Low Risk category

3rd grade: 94% of students scored in the Some Risk or Low Risk category

4th grade: 89% of students scored in the Some Risk or Low Risk category

4th grade: 94% of students scored in the Some Risk or Low Risk category



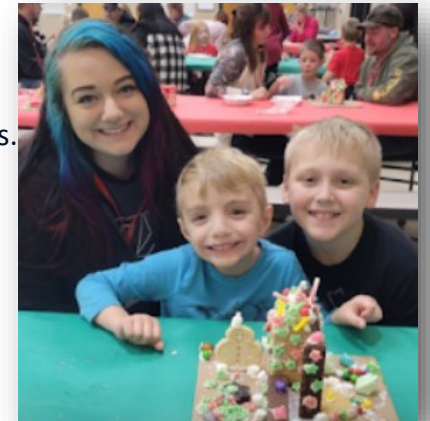
Services

Safety/Security

All of our outside doors are locked during the day. Visitors must ring the doorbell at the main entrance before being allowed to enter. All visitors who are staying for a period of time must sign in at the office and wear the lanyard that is provided. The lanyard advises staff and students that the visitor has registered in the office. We welcome volunteers in our classrooms. All volunteers working with students must have a background check completed and approved. Throughout the year, we practice safety drills for fire, tornado, lockdown and evacuating the playground in an emergency.
